## Camp Kitchen Essentials

### COOKING EQUIPMENT AND STORAGE

- Aluminium foil, cling wrap, baking paper
- BBQ bricks/fire lighters
- Car fridge or esky with ice
- Cooking oil/spray (avoid that sticky hotplate)
- Elastic bands
- Garbage bags
- Gas bottle/cylinders
- Head lamp/lantern (also great for ghost stories)
- Heat-proof gloves
- Matches/lighter
- Paper towels and napkins
- Stove/BBQ
- String
- Tablecloth and clips
- Water jug/containers
- Zip-lock bags

- Can opener
- Chopping board

- Knives, forks and spoons
- Measuring jugs/cups/spoons
- Meat thermometer
- Mixing bowl
- Mugs and plastic cups
- Plates and bowls
- Pots and pans
- Scissors

- Sharp knives
- Skewers
- Spatula
- Strainer
- Stubby holder (say no to warm beer)
- Thermos (say no to cold tea/coffee)
